#### **Additional Charges**

The fees cover the cost of most books, all meals for boarders and lunch for day pupils. We aim to keep any additional costs to a minimum but parents should expect some extra charges.

#### **Scholarships**

Some scholarships are available and further details are available on request.

#### **\*Application for Visa**

Students from outside the European Economic Area will require a Tier 4 visa prior to entering the UK and studying at the School. St Edmund's School Canterbury is recognised by the UK Border Agency as a Highly Trusted Sponsor and can issue a Confirmation of Acceptance of Studies (CAS) to those students who are offered an unconditional place at the School. Applications for a Tier 4 visa can be made at any British Embassy or High Commission. Those students who are already in the UK and wish to study at St Edmund's, a Tier 4 application can be made in the country (either in person or by post).

As St Edmund's School Canterbury has Highly Trusted Status the School can accept in-country applications whilst the application for a Tier 4 visa is pending with the UK Border Agency. Obtaining the CAS from the School is only one part of the visa application process. Students seeking a Tier 4 visa should ensure that they are aware of the visa requirements and are able to demonstrate that they have the required supporting documentation available for the School to see before CAS is issued.
